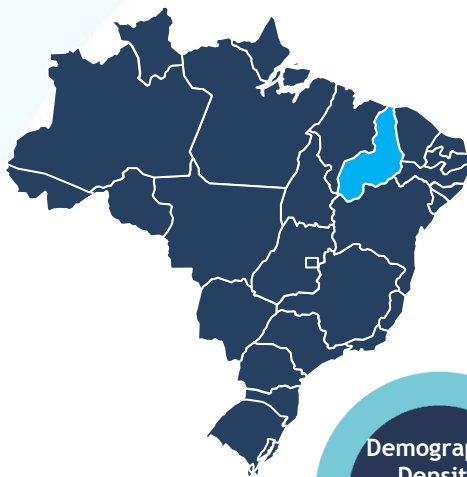

The full subconcession of water and sewage to the municipality of **Teresina** represents to the Company the **first concession** in the State of **Piauí**, Northeast Region, the **48<sup>th</sup> municipality, operating now in 10 states**. The term of the operation is until 2047.

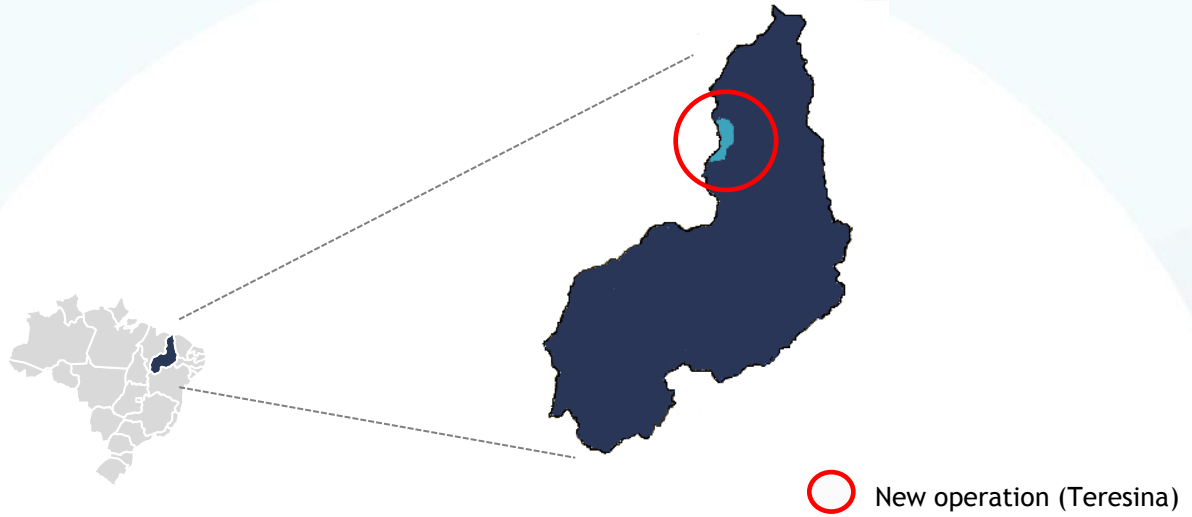
